



PROPOSITION 65 – WARNING NOTICE

Pursuant to California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 – Proposition 65

Dear Valued Customer,

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, known as Proposition 65, is published in Title 22, Section 12000, of the California Code of Regulations. This code states that businesses may not expose individuals to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning.

Nurse Assist, Inc. hereby provides notice that Ethylene Oxide (EO) is used in the sterilization process of our procedure trays. This sterilization process can leave trace residual amounts of EO on the products and their packaging. This chemical is known to cause cancer. Our products comply fully with the standards established by governing regulatory bodies as well as our own internal standards regarding safety, efficacy and labeling.
